My sincere joy today, as we celebrate the Investiture of our Chancellor, His Royal Majesty, Alhaji Ibrahim Ibn El-Kanemi, the Shehu of Dikwa, and the Matriculation Ceremony of our 2nd set of students into the Federal University of Health Sciences, Ila-Orangun.

I am particularly delighted to observe the colourful and ecstatic mood of this August congregation in this arena. I appreciate all the dignitaries who have found time to attend and felicitate with us despite your busy schedule. ## **Being the Text of The Matriculation Lecture Titled “Leveraging the Emergence of Specialised Medical Universities to Bridge the Performance Gaps in Nigeria's Healthcare Delivery” Delivered by the Guest Lecturer, Emeritus Professor Adewale Akinsola (Md, Fmcp, Fwacp, Frcp, Dfmc)**

Protocol

The spiralling increase of specialised medical universities has generated concerns in many circles. There are over 14 such institutions, with at least 7 being Federal or State government owned while some are private owned.

The Federal University of Health Sciences, Ila Orangun was licensed in 2021 among others. There is a trend for many more to be located in each geopolitical zone of the country. The major rhetorical questions revolve around 'Funding prospects and sustainability of the quality of the products.'

Setting up specialised universities had been a strategy by the Government in the past to bridge performance gaps in various aspects of our socio-economic, agricultural, educational, and technological development. The specialised universities were set up in Teacher Education, Agriculture and Technology, and they have become so popular in Nigeria.

The outcome and impacts they promised could scarcely justify the huge investments, and ironically, most of the universities have reversed to the conventional university system. Nigeria's socio-economic status, the technology and/or the educational sectors have not been significantly impacted. Although, arguably, there are many other putative factors militating against success, the universities have not been able to exonerate themselves.

The new trend of setting up specialised medical universities is conceivably a critical strategy to confront the serious and formidable challenges of our healthcare delivery affecting its effectiveness, efficiency, quality, access, availability and sustainability.

Some of the challenges are highlighted as follows.

- (a) Deficits in medical professions personnel resources.

Table 1 shows the disparities between the available numbers and WHO standards in some of the disciplines.

### Health Professions (Personnel) Resource Deficits in Nigeria

- b. There is a frequent attrition of the personnel through the famous JAPA syndrome. In the last 1-2 years, well over 2000 health professionals including doctors/nurses/physiotherapists and laboratory scientists have been affected.
- There is a perennial and intensive rivalry between health professionals, with poor team spirit, and a breakdown of industrial harmony.
  - Health professionals have limited adaptive skills for practice in the rural setting. A large number through the hospitals in the cities leading to a gross disparity in urban/rural distribution.
  - Training and learning in health professions education is mostly in the teaching hospitals, which have become so grossly inadequate due to (i) limited access by patients due to cost; (ii) Unsustainable infrastructure, (iii) high cost of healthcare delivery in such setting
    - Increase in cost and unaffordability of health professions education.
    - Unsustainable funding by the proprietors due to dwindling resources.
    - There is an apparent neglect of the value the facilities in the primary and secondary healthcare centres can provide for health professions education.
    - There is a skewed/inappropriate production of health professionals with an emphasis on some than others, leading to a disproportion in the different professional disciplines.
    - Limited/inadequate exposure and training in soft skills – adaptive skills for community-based practice; skills for leadership/communication and

entrepreneurship, ICT and innovations.

Training deficiency in teamwork, and a shared sense of community, the health professions education should be community-based, population-driven, and with shared commitments, concern and responsibility.

The several challenges to the health care delivery in Nigeria provoke a paradigm shift in the concept of health professions education, and thus provide a huge opportunity for the specialized university of Health Sciences for impactful solutions. And, this should be the overarching mission of this university.

The health professions education philosophy should centre around:-

- (1) The health team approach
- (2) Use of a model of a pyramidal network of health facilities including, health clinics, primary health centres, general hospitals, state hospitals and the teaching hospital.
- (3) Appropriate curriculum, guided by the CCMAS of the NUC, International best practices and the university's educational philosophy.
- (4) Community-based, population-driven and a shared sense of community within a health community.
- (5) The curriculum should be explicit on
  - Health promotion
  - Disease prevention
  - Disease control and treatment
  - Rehabilitation

What to do.

The health team concept

This will include – Doctors/Dentist/Nurses/Physiotherapist, Medical Laboratory Scientists/Nutrition, Health Records/ informatics /pharmacy, Public/Health officers, etc.

These are trained in appropriate numbers in the same environment within the various healthcare facilities (primary/health centres/secondary and tertiary health facilities guided by the philosophy of a shared sense of community.) The “ivory tower” concept of training with the teaching hospital should be de-emphasized as it is only to complement other training. The university should identify such training centres in the health community.

The curriculum should be expansive and inclusive to accommodate the NUC CCMAS, and international best practices and be guided by the university's philosophy.

It should be able to inculcate adaptive skills for appropriate attitudes and behaviours, a shared sense of community and responsibility, (2) critical core clinical skills and abilities from the onset of the training programme; also other soft skills such as – leadership, administration, ICT, innovation, entrepreneurship, bioethics, self-learning.

Teachers are very crucial to operationalising this strategy. Specific training and retraining, which emphasizes the component of services and a re-alignment of focus from an isolated “ivory tower” mentality to the community orientation.

Challenges:

- (1) The stakeholders' entrenched beliefs, attitudes and behaviours, background and outlook – Training and retraining/Re-orientation.
- (2) The “Ivory tower” mentality

- (3) Underdeveloped infrastructure in the community health facilities
- (4) Unawareness of the rights of the population to healthcare
- (5) Interprofessional disharmony due to training in 'silos' and hierarchical relationship
- (6) Inappropriate curriculum and models to operationalize the new concept.
- (7) A consensus by all stakeholders operators/government (national/sub-national levels/ and the community). The

Nigeria National Council of Health should deliberate extensively for a consensus, to streamline health professions training.

- (8) Institutional empowerment – financial, legal and other instruments.
- (9) Partnership/collaboration by the specialized universities and the health community.

## Conclusion

We should harness the potential of the specialized medical university to build a resilient, responsive and effective health community, with good health indices, contributing to the socio-economic well-being of the nation; a health community with inbuilt capabilities to control disasters/epidemics. This should be the cherished goal of the Federal University of Health Sciences, Ila Orangun.
